



International Collaboration Strengthens Yayasan JCorp's Recycling Initiative

On 23 April, 2024, Yayasan JCorp welcomed an esteemed delegation from the Korean Environment Corporation (K-Eco), Korea Resource Circulation Service Agency (KORA), Malaysian Recycling Alliance (MAREA), and Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM) to its innovative Drive-Thru Recycling hub at @B5 Johor Street Market, Johor Bahru. This visit was strategically timed to coincide with the Cooperation Coordination Committee (CCC) meeting between SWCorp and K-Eco in Johor Bahru, reflecting the growing international collaboration in solid waste management. The delegation, led by Dr. Youn Young-Bong, Director of the Global Strategy Department at K-Eco, was warmly received by Ts. Sahir Kunju bin Abdul Karim, Director of the 3R Division at SWCorp and Puan Wan Su Ali, General Manager of Yayasan JCorp.

The main purpose of the visit was to observe the drive-thru recycling operations in Johor Bahru and strengthen collaboration between the agencies involved in recycling efforts.

Tree Planting Project - “A Seed Today, a Forest Tomorrow, for a Healthier Life”

On 25 May, 2024, KPJ Ipoh Specialist Hospital teamed up with the Perak State Forestry Department for an inspiring initiative as part of Malaysia’s 100 Million Tree Planting Campaign. This project, driven by a commitment to environmental stewardship, saw the planting of 173 trees at the Bukit Kinta Forest Reserve along the Simpang Pulai - Cameron Highlands route.
