The e-Bulletin MEMBELA showcases JCorp's commitment and devotion




Yayasan Johor Corporation (Yayasan JCorp) initiated the MEMBELA e-Bulletin, with the aim to document its initiatives as public record and reference. This bulletin was created to inform stakeholders about the corporate social responsibility activities undertaken by Johor Corporation (JCorp) and its Group of Companies during the year 2022.

With the implementation of the 2022-2026 Sustainability Plan to achieve the Group's Corporate ESG Agenda, Yayasan JCorp was restructured in 2020 to increase its effectiveness and expand CSR's role. A major part of this involves revamping and rebuilding the organisation's structure in to implement initiatives and take on a more significant role,

such as implementing programmes to support the ESG agenda.

The new restructuring displays, among other things – the centralisation of all Group of Companies' CSR. This effort allowed JCorp to consolidate funds, coordinate programmes, and channel a more transparent chain of command using a central channel, Yayasan JCorp. Until today, these steps remain crucial in order to implement the Group of Companies' CSR.

The effort can be seen through Yayasan JCorp's programmes which cover four key areas namely Education, Arts, Culture & Heritage, Environmental, and Community Well-being. These principles are very much crucial to improve the quality of life of the segmented groups in Johor, as well as at the national level.

KidsEdu's English Programme provides double boosts



The collaboration between Yayasan JCorp and Deloitte Malaysia in spearheading the Deloitte KidsEdu Programme has boosted the students' proficiency in the English language, and spirit of volunteerism.

The programme was first created in June 2021 after the wake of COVID-19 and to encourage early participation from the low-income children of JCorp Group of Companies employees. This programme was initiated concurrently with the Primary School Tuition Project - Strive For Success programme.

The programme has been implemented across six Johor schools until 2022, and more than 240 students have benefited from it thanks to Deloitte Malaysia volunteers, which included ten other Johor Student Leader Council (JSLC) members from SMK (P) Sultan Ibrahim, SMK Mohd Khalid, and Maktab Sultan Abu Bakar instructors.

Hopefully, the Deloitte KidsEdu Programme will encourage the students and community to communicate more in English, particularly the B40 families.



Despite this, there was an urgent need to ease access to digital technology, particularly in rural regions. Deloitte Malaysia and Yayasan JCorp donated 30 laptops to selected students to tackle this issue. It will be easier for these students to access learning materials with them.

On 7 June 2022, six students from standard 2 to standard 6 were presented with tablets for excelling in their examinations. Hopefully, these initiatives can be a great motivation for other students to do even better.

The field of education is dynamic, and its components must be upgraded in tandem with the demand for human capital and the industry's technical advancements.

To address this, additional programme modules were added to Yayasan JCorp's Secondary School Tuition Project which incorporates Mata Pelajaran Elektif Ikhtisas (MPEI).

To achieve this, Yayasan JCorp has conducted the MPEI Module Construction Workshop intending to create new modules for the programme. The tuition was a great collaboration with the TVET Unit of the Johor Education Department (JPNJ).

Hopefully, students who took part in the tuition will flourish in the Malaysia Certificate of Examination (SPM), especially in the MPEI subjects. The tuition is still in full swing since 2021, and it includes MPEI subjects, namely business, economics, and accounting.

This programme has so far benefited over 2,250 students from 15 secondary schools in Johor. Clearly, JCorp and its Group of Companies are committed to fostering top-notch human capital.

184 students participated in the industrial & skills training programme

Over 184 students showed promising outcomes as 28 of them were able to secure employment while the majority of them continued their education after participating in the Industrial Training and Skills Program.

This achievement marks another milestone for Yayasan JCorp, which has contributed to the betterment of the community while changing the socioeconomic status of the participants.

The training programme was first introduced in 2020, with the aim to provide practical exposure to the participants. The programme was specifically designed to prepare the participants for real working experience and help them improve their marketability in their respective fields of skills, especially in Johor.

In addition, Yayasan JCorp has also organised the Johor TVET Education Sharing Seminar, which was conducted by the Southern Region Skills Development Department and TVET Success Sharing with the help of three alumni from Yayasan JCorp's Industrial Training and Skills Programme. More than 500 participants attended the virtual seminar, including participants from industrial training and students from TVET and PVMA streams.

RM850,000 has been allocated for B40 students pursuing ACCA studies

Our nation is still working to develop its professional human capital, which includes increasing the number of Professional Bumiputera Accountants on the market.

As a state development organisation, Johor Corporation (JCorp) has lived up to this objective by allocating RM850,000 in order to fund eight outstanding students from B40 families to continue their studies in ACCA professional accounting. The education aid was funded through JCorp Group's zakat contribution and was supported by the Malaysia Professional Accountancy Centre (MyPAC) through the exchange of a Cooperation Agreement for ACCA education sponsorship on 26 October 2022.

According to the Chairman of Yayasan JCorp, Encik Rozaini Mohd Sani, one of these funding objective is to ease the burden the B40 families by financing their children to a higher education level while ensuring competitive marketability in the industry.

Yayasan JCorp took this opportunity as a way to ensure that B40 students can have better access to higher education without difficulties. In addition it encourage them to achieve better academic results.

Even more exciting was the fact that the students who completed the ACCA programme have secured job placements in the nearest time, not to mention getting overseas employment – namely in the United Kingdom, United Arab Emirates, and Bahrain.

It was a continuation of the JCorp Chartered Accountancy Program (JCAP) initiative of 2015, which entailed RM2.7 million. To date, at least 26 certified accountants were trained and now serving in JCorp and Group of Companies.

On a side note, the ACCA platform provides training for accounting students and it offers either certificate of qualification or the title of Chartered Accountant. ACCA is recognised in 180 countries including Malaysia, and it has over 170,000 members and 436,000 students worldwide.

A visit to Temasek Foundation gives an insight into the STEM programme

On 6 October 2022, Yayasan JCorp visited the Temasek Foundation in Singapore in order to better understand the world of STEM. The visit to Singapore was accompanied by officials from the Johor State Education Department and the Sultan Ibrahim Johor Foundation to observe the possibilities of collaboration in STEM subjects, namely technology and skills as well as English proficiency. The delegation also toured the Temasek Shophouse, the National Institute of Education (NIE), and the 3D Printing Workshop Centre.

This effort is in line with the objectives of Malaysia's Digital Economy Action Framework and the National 4IR Policy, among others providing Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) knowledge to students, teachers, and the general public.

Thus, Yayasan JCorp is dedicated to preparing organisations to take on more challenging roles and setting new benchmarks for the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programme of JCorp Group of Companies. This is to help them generate skilled human capital while guaranteeing high earnings when they join the workforce.

The Yayasan JCorp has initiated its first engagement with STEM education, which will be included under its Education focus.

The panel consists of Prof Madya Dr Johari Surif, Director of Centre for Community & Industry Network, the Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM); Puan Noor Ruzilawati Ruddin, General Manager Yayasan JCorp; and Dr Zulaikah Mohamed, Specialist in Microbiology (SME), Johor Bahru Public Health Laboratory.

In this occasion, Yayasan JCorp and Johor Education Department hosted a forum titled 'Pendidikan STEM Penuhi Keperluan Bakat Masa Depan', on 8 November 2022. The forum was digitally live-streamed on the sites of both organisations. It was attended by 250 participants, including teachers and students from primary and secondary schools across the country.

This programme is consistent with Yayasan JCorp's emphasis on education, which aims to produce future generations of individuals with a wide range of highly developed skills, including STEM education. On the other hand, this occasion will produce future human capital that will be highly marketable.

One of the projects is the Arts, Culture & Heritage Quarter Project in the region of Ibrahim International Business District (IIBD). Yayasan JCorp and ThinkCity have partnered on this initiative in a strategic relationship. The initiatives comprise 27 programmes, of which three initiatives were initially put into action: the Artist Residency Programme, the Downtown Johor Bahru Grant Programme, and the Urban Forest Development Project.

In addition, Yayasan JCorp has planned a collaboration with KPJ Healthcare Berhad to include an art gallery within all KPJ Hospital networks, respectively. This project was further strengthened with the help of the National Art Gallery of Malaysia. The existence of the gallery can potentially promote the work of local artists while improving the value and reputation of the respective hospitals.

Other than that, there was a collaboration with B5 Johor Street Market to organise a few interesting artistic activities including performance art and street art. To bolster personal qualities by appreciating our culture and heritage values, Yayasan JCorp will continue to organise the webinar series programme.




